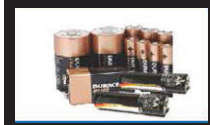


# Quick guide to recycling in your **blue bin**

Use the black caddy for



**Batteries**  
(in a clear plastic bag on top of glass)



**Mixed glass**  
(bottles and jars, rinsed)

Keep these separate to make sure they can be recycled.



The main part of the bin is used for



**Newspapers and magazines**



**Paper, leaflets and envelopes**



**Telephone directories**



**Cardboard and cartons (squashed)**



**Food tins and drink cans (rinsed and squashed)**



**Aerosols (empty)**



**Plastic bottles (rinsed and squashed)**

**Not to be placed in your recycling bin**



**black bin bags**



**Plastic pots, trays or plastic bags**



**Textiles**



**Food waste**



**Nappies**

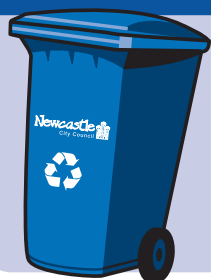
